Department of English & Foreign Languages offers Diploma of Proficiency in French of 06 months duration for non graduates, under the semester and Grade system of the University.

Aims and Objectives:

- To enable the learner to attain A2 level of Common European Framework for French
- To enable the learners to listen and understand the spoken French language of intermediate level.
- To enable the learners to speak and engage in simple conversations in French.
- To enable the learners to read and understand the intermediate level texts in French
