From the inception of University, the Department of Computer Science and Engineering was a part of the Faculty of Engineering & Technology. In its meeting held on March 31, 2010, the Executive Council has changed the nomenclature of the Department and has also changed the constitution of two faculties of the University, namely, Faculty of Physical Sciences and the Faculty of Engineering & Technology.

In its decision, the Executive Council has made the following changes:

- A. Nomenclature of the Department of Computer Science and Engineering has been changed to the Department of Computer Science and Application.
- B. Department of Computer Science & Applications has been assigned to the Faculty of Physical Sciences in place of Faculty of Engineering & Technology.

Sir, here it may be mentioned that Section 23 (2) para 2 of the University Act provides for the following:

"that the Executive Council shall not make, amend or repeal any Statute, affecting the status, powers or constitution of any of the authority of the University until such authority has been given an opportunity of expressing an opinion in writing on the proposed changes, and any opinion so expressed shall be considered by the Executive Council."

Before affecting the changes (A and B above) in the University authorities, none of the authorities being affected (erstwhile Faculty of Engineering & Technology, Faculty of Physical Sciences, and the then Department of Computer Science and Engineering) were given an opportunity to express its opinion in writing.

Sir, you are requested to take necessary steps so as to alleviate the discrepancies in this regard.
