 - vii) University Teaching Departments should initiate the self-sustainable training/internship programmes during vacations and fees be got decided by the competent authorities.
 - viii) The University should ask the students to register on PARAKH of the AICTE to measure the benchmark levels and gain in academic and aptitude skills by the students in technical programs and to understand the various factors that affect skill development of students in Technical Institutes across India.
 - ix) Teachers should be trained in the development of pedagogy as per new ways of teaching.
 - The University should emphasize on latest programmes like Artificial Intelligence, Cyber Security, Data Science, Robotics and block chain etc.

38.10 To consider and approve the Guidelines/Policy for Ph.D. coursework: Classes at Central University of Haryana and other University instead of Ch. Devi Lal University, Sirsa.

Considered and approved the following:

- The Credit requirement for the Ph.D. coursework is a minimum of 12 credits, including a "Research and Publication Ethics" and a Research Methodology course. The Research Advisory Committee (RAC) can also recommend UGC recognized online courses as part of the credit requirements for the Ph.D. programme.
- 2. For ensuring flexibility and promoting research collaborations, the research scholar can be allowed to pursue his/her coursework by the Vice-Chancellor on the recommendations of the Research Advisory Committee from any of the State Universities within Haryana/Central Universities of India. Further, it is mandated that courses opted by the research scholars are approved by the Research Advisory Committee of the concerned research scholar. In case the research scholar is not allowed to pursue online courses by the RAC, then the research scholar is expected to fulfil the attendance requirements as per UGC rules. The certification of coursework from the institution attended for the Ph.D. programme is mandatory and be submitted before Ph.D. registration.

- The research scholar must obtain a minimum of 55% marks or its equivalent grade in the UGC 10- point scale in the coursework to be eligible to continue in the programme.
- 4. All Ph.D. research scholars are required to pay fee as per the University norms (even when pursuing Ph.D. coursework from the institutions of his/her choice) and in case joining other institution for Ph.D. coursework then he/she has to pay both parent institution fee and also institution where joining for Ph.D. course work.
- 38.11 To consider and approve the Guidelines/Policy regarding relocation/transfer Ph.D. admission from private University to Ch. Devi Lal University, Sirsa.

Considered and approved the following:

The admission of the candidate can be considered by this University provided:

- (i) The candidate has been admitted in the Private University through entrance test/ UGC rules.
- (ii) The completion of coursework is only through regular mode.
- (iii) The Private University should be NAAC accredited with 'A' grade.
- 1. The consent of the research supervisor duly recommend by the concerned Chairperson is required regarding before relocation/transfer Ph.D. admission.
