The upper financial outlay of upto Rs. 1 Crore for making purchase on the GeM have been inviting attention of the State Government for its effective and accelerated implementation. The matter has been considered and it has been decided that the upper financial outlay for procuring Goods/Stores/Services by all the Govt. Departments/Govt. Agencies State will be upto Rs.5 Crores.
