
\*The ICSSR limits its budget to Rs.5, 00,000/- (Rs. Five Lakhs Only)

The approval is in accordance with the following guidelines:

- (j) The date of commencement of the research project is 07 December 2015 and is to be completed in two years.

- (ii) Your Institution viz. Chaudhary Devi Lal University, Haryana has to agree to affiliate your research project and agree to administer the funds.
- (iii) The ICSSR will issue the sanction letter and release the funds to the affiliating organization on receipt of affiliation letter mentioned above and the grant-in-aid bill duly signed by its competent authority.
- (iv) The affiliating Institute will maintain accounts of expenditure and forward audited statement of accounts to the ICSSR and refund the unspent balance, if any, on completion of the project.
- (v) The Indian Lead Collaborator viz. Prof. Raj Kumar Siwach will draw grant from the Affiliating Institution as and when required as per the requirements in accordance with the guidelines.
- (vi) The Indian Lead Collaborator shall have full discretion to spend the funds as per approved budget heads and amount of the budget to carry out the visits as per the approved research proposal.
- (vii) The Indian Lead Collaborator will submit the progress report of the work done alongwith a statement of expenditure incurred.
- (viii) The Lead Collaborator will be fully responsible to interact with Lead Collaborator in South Africa and ensure his/her concurrence before launching the activity.
- (ix) The Indian scholars visiting South Africa will be eligible for International travel costs (economy class lowest fare) by Air India, visa charges, and local/domestic travel costs in India.
- (x) The Indian scholars visiting South Africa will ensure the arrangements of boarding, lodging and maintenance as per norms of that country in connivance with the Lead Collaborator in South Africa.
- (xi) The South African scholars visiting India will be entitled to accommodation, maintenance, local/domestic travel (maximum two Indian cities).
- (xii) Intermediate report is to be submitted by July 2016. The researchers should submit the same report to both ICSSR and NIHSS.
- (xiii) ICSSR usually transfers 40% of the grant at the beginning of the first year of the project, 40% at the beginning of the second year, and 20% at the end of the project.
- (xiv) The research project is also governed by the guidelines of the "Joint Call for Research Proposals 2015".
- (xv) The ICSSR reserves the right to change/alter the norms/guidelines to facilitate the research work and funding.
- (xvi) After completion of the Project, the Lead Collaborator is required to submit the final report of the Project within three months of the completion of the research work. The final report should mention the output (such as working papers that should lead to publications). Publications should mention the possible policy applications of the results of the research. The publications should also mention the ICSSR-NIHSS Joint Research Programme in the Social Sciences as source of funding.

You are, therefore, requested to kindly submit an affiliation letter to the ICSSR duly signed by the competent authority of the Chaudhary Devi Lal University, Haryana in the enclosed format along with the budget estimates as per the guidelines of the Call in order to release a formal sanction letter relating to your research project.






