MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

The Chaudhary Devi Lal University (CDLU), Sirsa (Haryana) hereafter referred to as of the first party

And

Prof. Ajmer Singh Malik (A.S. Malik), Retd. Professor, Deptt. of Public Administration, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra hereafter referred to as of the second party

The CDLU and Prof. A.S. Malik are individually referred to as first party and second party and collectively as the parties.

Whereas

1. According to the scheme of MHRD, Govt. of India, UGC (Credit Framework for Online Learning Courses through SWAYAM) Regulation, 2016, Guidelines for developing online courses for SWAYAM 1st June, 2017, the Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs) under UGC is the key part of the Universities.
2. Prof. A.S. Malik who is the Course Coordinator of the MOOC on Introduction to Public Administration, a four credit course produced as per the SWAYAM Guidelines and for effective adoption, implementation, operation of this MOOC, the Course Coordinator also have a key role in its delivery.

5. The CDLU will issue a credit transfer certificate regarding successful completion of the MOOC as per the norms laid down by the UGC/National Coordinator, Ministry of Education in this regard.
6. The CDLU will provide ordinance, rules, regulations for the smooth effective offering of the MOOCs to operationalize this MOU.
7. The CDLU will arrange through the office of Dean Academic Affairs to send the receipts of the grant(s) received from the funding institutions in favour of the second party from the UGC/CEC/Concerned agency regarding this MOOC or remuneration bills of the expenses incurred/utilization certificates etc. in the format and manner required by the concerned agencies.
8. The CDLU will arrange to receive the financial grants or any financial assistance for the addition/revision/modifications/development of this MOOC in favour of the second party and will release the same to the second party on demand.
9. The CDLU will be obliged to discharge all those responsibilities required for compliance of the relevant norms laid down by the all concerned agencies including Ministry of Education/UGC/CEC etc., for the effective implementation of MOOCs Guidelines.
10. The CDLU will submit an undertaking for the second party as required.

Responsibility of Second Party

1. The Course Coordinator shall ensure that the course offered as per schedule.
2. The Course Coordinator will be responsible for announcing the course and interact with the stake holders and learners for enrolment of students in the MOOC on Introduction to Public Administration.
3. The Second party shall assist the first party in developing ordinance, rules, regulations etc. regarding the MOOC on Introduction to Public Administration.
4. The Second party shall perform all functions required for effective delivery of the course including participation in discussion forums, preparing quizzes and assignments and final examinations.
5. The Second party shall guide, coordinate, cooperate, assist the enrolled students of the MOOC and evaluate them based on pre-defined norms laid down by the concerned agencies and shall award marks/grades.
6. The Second party shall cooperate and coordinate with the national coordinator in discharging exam and result related activities/functions.
7. The second party shall ensure the re-development of course, if asked by the national coordinator as per the UGC and other controlling bodies norms and free from plagiarism, copyright laws as well as comply with the norms set by the concerns further with approval of the approving body.
8. The course developed by the second party will be the property of the SWAYAM and the first party as well as students having user right of the course.

3. The CDLU is keenly desire to be an Host Institution of the MOOC and ready to transfer the credits to all those students/learners who enrolled and successfully complete the course as per the guidelines issued from time to time by the Ministry of HRD/Education, Govt. of India and other concerned agencies involved in the development, delivery and certification of MOOCs in the country and being Course Coordinator of the MOOC on Introduction to Public Administration, Prof. A.S. Malik is keen to associate the University in delivering the course.
4. Accordingly, the first party (CDLU) desires to act as Host Institution and the second party as Course Coordinator.

Now, therefore, in consideration of the mutual promises set forth herein, the sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Parties hereby agree to enter into this MOU as follows:

SCOPE

In order to adopt, operate, implement, run the MOOC, this MoU intends, the SWAYAM Coordinator and office of the Controller of Examinations (COE) of the CDLU Sirsa and the Course Coordinator Prof. Ajmer Singh Malik to do all the needful activities in effective management of the course, which overall is in the benefit of all concerned stakeholders, i.e., the University, Course Coordinator and the students/learners.

GOVERNANCE

The MOU is governed by the scheme of MHRD, Ministry of Education, Govt. of India, UGC (Credit Framework for Online Learning Courses through SWAYAM) Regulation, 2016, Guidelines for Developing Online Courses for SWAYAM 1st June, 2017 and other guidelines/directions/rules and regulations/notifications/orders issued by the UGC or sister agencies for the Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs), (first party) ordinance, rules, regulations (to be framed/provided for MOOCs alongwith changes/amendments from time to time.

RESPONSIBILITY

Responsibility of first party (CDLU)

1. The UGC has issued UGC (Credit Framework for Online Learning Courses through SWAYAM) regulation 2016 and operational guidelines etc. which apply to all Universities including the CDLU.
2. The CDLU is a State University duly authorised to award degrees as per UGC Act.
3. The CDLU being Host Institution facilitates transfer of credits for a MOOCs to the students on successful completion of each course, the Host Institution offering the MOOCs will issue the credit transfer certificates alongwith the number of credits and grades, through which the student can get credits transferred into the transcript, issued in his/her parent institution.
4. The CDLU will never refuse to any student for credit transfer for the course earned through MOOC on Introduction of Public Administration.

- 9. The Course should strictly comply with quality and other parameter prescribed in the relevant guidelines. A compliance certificate in this regard has already been submitted by the second party to the national coordinator.
- 10. The Second party will submit the bills (remuneration and expenses if any) regarding the course to the first party for further transmission to the UGC/CEC/Concerned.
- 11. Receipt of payment by the second party shall be regulated by the norms prevalent in the first party


Limitation/Miscellaneous


This MOU will effective from 13.12.2021 and shall be in operation until revoked by either party by way of 03 months prior written notice to the other party but with effect from new session. The ongoing session will be completed. The MOU will be subject to the norms of the MHRD, UGC, NCTE and will effective until it is incompliance to the norms. The changes in the norms will be deemed part of this MOU and its effect. The acts of force measures will not create any liability to any party. This MOU is an agreement/mutual understanding of the parties for the increase of credibility and goodwill and will work on the cooperation and coordination.


Residuary/Jurisdiction/Interpretation

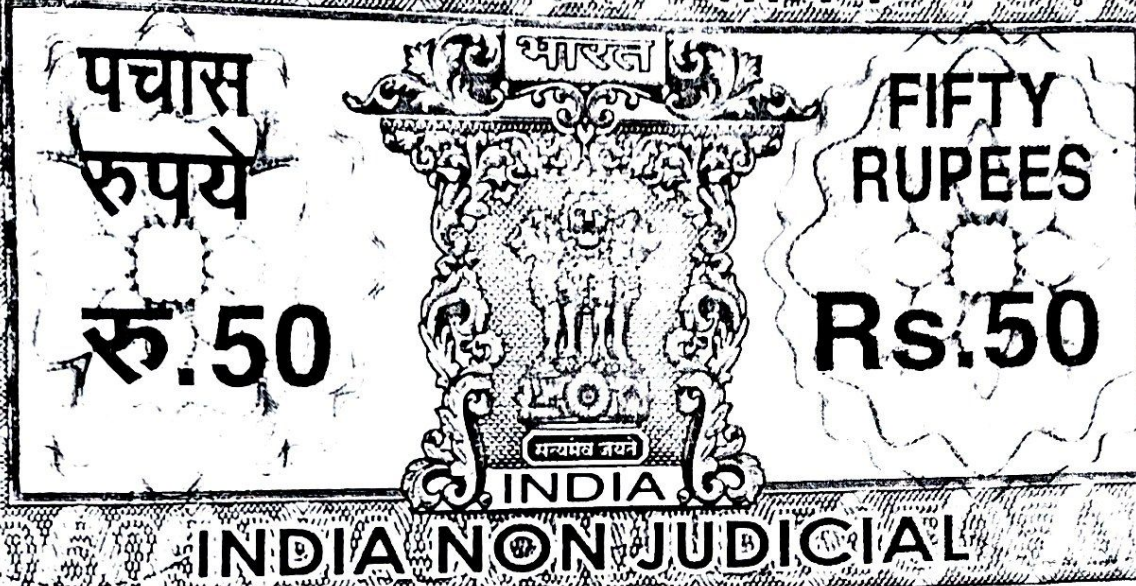

Bose University of Science & Technology, YMCA Faridabad, Haryana join in the following academic alliance. Both, J. C. Bose University of Science & Technology, YMCA, Faridabad and Chaudhary Devi Lal University, Sirsa are committed to working together to develop specific agreements on the points above. These agreements will provide logistical and management details appropriate to the successful operation of the program. These agreements will fulfill the spirit and purpose of this general academic alliance.

DURATION and TERMINATION

This academic alliance shall commence on its date of execution by the Parties and will be terminated:

- (a) after 36 months; or
 - (b) at any time for convenience by either party with 30 days' written notice; or
- whichever of the above occurs the earlier.

Notwithstanding this understanding, the academic alliance may be subject to modification or revision by mutual written agreement.

ASSIGNMENT

No party can assign this agreement to any other party without the consent of each other.

LEGAL COMPLIANCE

Jurisdictional Laws: The parties acknowledge that activities under this academic alliance, depending on their nature, be subject to law of the land. Each party agrees to assist the other party to understand the requirements of the local laws in relation to activities undertaken under this academic alliance.

LOGOS, NAMES, AND MARKS

The parties agree that neither this document nor any performances or actions taken in connection therewith shall create a partnership or joint venture between them, and that neither shall advertise, state or otherwise imply anything to the contrary. Unless otherwise agreed in writing, neither party shall use, display, or otherwise engage the logos, names, trademarks, or other identification or protected intellectual property of the other.

RESOLUTION

The parties resolve to negotiate on all issues in an open and cooperative manner. Should any dispute arise between them in relation to this academic alliance, the parties shall seek to resolve them on the basis of mutual trust and cooperation. Should no such resolution be achieved, the parties shall state their disagreement in writing and either party may exercise its right to terminate this memorandum forthwith and without prejudice or penalty.

FORCE MAJURE

Neither Party shall have any liability whatsoever or be deemed to be in default for any delay or failure in performance under this alliance resulting from acts beyond the control of that Party including but not limited to acts of God, war or national emergency, accident, fire, riot or epidemics.

NOTICE

Any notice, approval, consent, request or other communication required or permitted to be given or made under this alliance will be in writing in the English language and will be served or delivered to the registered office address individual party as placed in this alliance in its preamble.

SEVERABILITY

If any provision of this agreement became invalid unenforceable, or prohibited by law such provisions shall be considered as inoperative and remainder will be operative and shall continue remain valid.

RELATIONSHIP

This duty shall survive even after the termination of this Academic Alliance for next 5 years after the expiry of the academic alliance.

AGREEMENT

The following signatories, on behalf of their respective organizations, agree, without prejudice, to meet the terms of the academic alliance.

Each party shall bear its own cost to implement this academic alliance.








MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN

Whereas, National Institute of Electronics and Information Technology, Kurukshetra, (hereinafter referred to as "NIELIT", which expression shall unless repugnant to the context thereof, include its successors and permitted assigns), is an autonomous scientific society under Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology (MeitY), Government of India and having its office in Government Polytechnic Campus, Umri - Kurukshetra and hereinafter unless the context otherwise requires be referred to as NIELIT.



Whereas, Chaudhary Devi Lal University has been a pioneer in successfully conducting Masters programs in Computer Applications, Applied Sciences, Life Sciences, Management and in Biotechnology hereinafter unless the context otherwise requires be referred to as Chaudhary Devi Lal University.

WHEREAS, both Chaudhary Devi Lal University and NIELIT, now

- Recognize the need to create momentum in capacity building of students in demand oriented areas like Artificial Intelligence, Machine Learning, Advance Web Development, IOT, Mobile Applications Development in the State of Haryana.
- Aiming to develop local talent to make the region self sufficient in these technologies.
- Intend to collaborate to train students in these advanced technologies to enhance their skills to increase their employability.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises made herein and of good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which both Chaudhary Devi Lal University and NIELIT hereby acknowledge and agree to sign a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) on date _____ at _____.

1: SCOPE OF THE MOU

The objective of this collaboration is to provide opportunity to facilitate the advancement of knowledge on the basis of reciprocity, best effort, mutual benefit and frequent interactions.

- i. Exchange of intellectual knowhow and resources.
- ii. Partnership in entrepreneurship driven opportunities and resources so as to launch the skill oriented, tailor made courses in line with Govt. of India's vision of Skill India, Digital India and Make in India.
- iii. Create the best academic and industry content for educating local talent attuned to the local requirements in advanced technologies.
- iv. Conduct workshops and training courses for students and faculties.
- v. Work towards creating socially responsible manpower that benefits the individual trainees as well as society, and support social entrepreneurship amongst students.
- vi. Bridge the gap between availability of capable, employable technical manpower and demand for the same.
- vii. Any other mutually agreed collaboration that is beneficial to the nation, society or students.



2: SCOPE AND TERMS OF INTERACTIONS

A. NIELIT

- i. Provide industry ready Training in advanced technologies such as Machine Learning, AI, Mobile Application Development, IoT, Advance Web Development etc.
- ii. Run Faculty Development Programmes and projects dissemination in colleges.
- iii. Run online career development workshops for the students of the University on how these advanced technologies can help in conducting campus interviews and also IT company interviews.
- iv. Co-teach modules on advanced technology areas.

B. Chaudhary Devi Lal University

- i. Filter good students for six months internship/6 week Summer Training at the NIELIT Kurukshetra
- ii. Provide mentorship to students on projects of interest
- iii. Produce e content for training students in advanced technologies
- iv. Provide a single point of contact that will help them participate in achieving the objectives of this MoU

3: EFFECTIVE DATE AND DURATION OF MOU

- i. The duration of the MOU shall be for a period of 5 years from the effective date.
- ii. During its tenancy, the MOU may be extended or terminated by a prior notice of not less than 3 months by either party. However, termination of the MOU will not in any manner affect the on-going projects or trainings being undertaken at that point of time under the MOU.
- iii. Any clause or article of the MOU may be modified or amended by mutual MOU of NIELIT and Chaudhary Devi Lal University.

4: CONFIDENTIALITY

- i. During the tenure of the MOU, both Chaudhary Devi Lal University and NIELIT will maintain strict confidentiality and prevent disclosure of all the information and data exchanged under the scope of this MOU for any purpose other than in accordance to this MOU.
- ii. Both Chaudhary Devi Lal University and NIELIT shall bind their respective personnel who come into possession or knowledge of any confidential information NOT to



disclose the same to third parties without written approval of the disclosing party or use such confidential information for any use other than intended under this MOU or PROJECTS.

- iii. Further both Chaudhary Devi Lal University and NIELIT shall put in place adequate and reasonable measures to keep and store confidential information secure so as to prevent any unauthorized use.
- iv. CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION shall mean any proprietary information, data or facts belonging to PARTIES collectively or severally, disclosed by the disclosing party under this MOU or any subsequent MOU, whether in writing, verbal or electronically, irrespective of the medium in which such information is stored, which is marked confidential or with any other words having similar meaning by the disclosing party, or specifically agreed to be kept confidential by the parties, or declared or identified so by the disclosing party before such disclosure or during the discussions.

However confidential information shall not include any data or information which

- a) Is or become publicly available through no fault of the receiving party
- b) Is already in the rightful possession of the receiving party prior to its receipt of such data or information;
- c) Is independently developed by the receiving party without reference to the confidential information of the disclosing party.
- d) Is rightfully obtained by the receiving party from a third party or is in the public domain.
- e) Is disclosed with the written consent of the party whose information it is, or
- f) Is disclosed pursuant to court order or other legal compulsion, after providing prior notice to the disclosing party.

5: AMENDMENTS

Any amendment add/or addenda to the MOU shall be in writing and signed by the PARTIES hereto and shall only after such execution be deemed to form part of the MOU and have the effect of modifying the MOU to the extent required by such amendment or addenda.



6: RESOLUTION OF DISPUTES

- i. This MOU shall take effect and be construed in accordance with the Laws of India and be subject to the jurisdiction of the courts at Kurukshetra.
- ii. The dispute or difference whatsoever arises between PARTIES in relation to or inconnection with this MOU both the parties shall first try to resolve the dispute/difference amicably between themselves, failing which the matter shall be referred to and settled through arbitration. The arbitration proceedings shall be held in accordance with the provision of THE ARBITRATION AND CONCILIATION (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2015. The venue of arbitration shall be Kurukshetra and Language of arbitration shall be English.

7: MISCELLANEOUS

- i. The headings and subheadings are inserted for convenience only and shall not affect the construction of this MOU.
- ii. Both Chaudhary Devi Lal University and NIELIT shall not, during the term of this MOU directly or indirectly, solicit or offer employment or engagement to any of the personnel of other party without the prior consent in writing of that other party
- iii. No failure to exercise and no delay in exercising, on the part of a Party, and right, remedy, power or privilege hereunder shall operate as a waiver thereof, nor shall any single or partial exercise of any right, remedy, power or privilege hereunder preclude any other or further exercise thereof or the exercise of any other right, remedy, power or privilege.
- iv. After this MOU has been signed, all preceding understandings/negotiations and correspondence pertaining to it shall become null and void.
