UNIVERSITY GRANTS COMMISSION NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 6th May, 2019

F.No. 14-4/2012(CPP-II).—In exercise of the powers conferred under clause (g) of sub-section (1) of Section 26 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 (3 of 1956), and in supersession of the University Grants Commission (Grievance Redressal) Regulations, 2012, the University Grants Commission hereby makes the following regulations, namely:

1. SHORT TITLE, APPLICATION AND COMMENCEMENT:


- These regulations shall be called as the University Grants Commission (Redressal Grievances of Students) Regulations, 2019.
- They shall apply to all higher education institutions, whether established or incorporated by or under a Central Act or a State Act, and every institution recognized by the University Grants Commission under clause (f) of Section 2 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 and to all institutions deemed to be a University declared as such under Section 3 therein.
- They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. OBJECTIVE:

To provide opportunities for redress of certain grievances of students already enrolled in an institution, as well as those seeking admission to such institutions, and a mechanism thereto.


3. DEFINITION: IN THESE REGULATIONS, UNLESS THE CONTEXT OTHERWISE REQUIRES-

- "Act" means the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 (3 of 1956).
- "aggrieved student" means a student, who has any complaint in the matters relating to or connected with the grievances defined under these regulations.
- "college" means any institution, so defined in clause (b) of sub-section (1) of section 2 of the Act.
- "Collegiate Student Grievance Redressal Committee" (CSGRC) means a committee constituted under these regulations, at the level of an institution, being a college.
- "Commission" means the University Grants Commission established under section 4 of the UGC Act, 1956.
- "declared admission policy" means such policy, including the process there under, for admission to a course or program of study as may be offered by the institution by publication in the prospectus of the institution.
- "Departmental Student Grievance Redressal Committee" (DSGRC) means a committee constituted under these regulations, at the level of a Department, School or Centre of an institution.
- "grievance" means, and includes, complaint(s) made by an aggrieved student in respect of the following, namely:


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- i. admission contrary to merit determined in accordance with the declared admission policy of the institution;
 - ii. irregularity in the process under the declared admission policy of the institution;
 - iii. refusal to admit in accordance with the declared admission policy of the institution;
 - iv. non-publication of prospectus by the institution, in accordance with the provisions of these regulations;
 - v. publication by the institution of any information in the prospectus, which is false or misleading, and not based on facts;
 - vi. withholding of, or refusal to return, any document in the form of certificate, diploma or any other award or other document deposited by a student for the purpose of seeking admission in such institution, with a view to induce or compel such student to pay any fee or fees in respect of any course or program of study which such student intends to pursue;
 - vii. demand of money in excess of that specified to be charged in the prospectus under the declared admission policy of the institution;
 - viii. violation, by the institution, of any law for the time being in force in regard to reservation of seats in admission to different category of students;
 - ix. nonpayment or delay in payment of scholarships or financial aid admissible to any student under the declared admission policy of such institution, or under the conditions of aid prescribed by the Commission;
 - x. delay by the institution in the conduct of examinations, or declaration of results, beyond the schedule specified in the academic calendar of the institution, or in such calendar prescribed by the Commission;
 - xi. failure by the institution to provide student amenities as set out in the prospectus required to be extended by the institution under any provisions of law for the time being in force;
 - xii. non-transparent or unfair practices adopted by the institution for the evaluation of students;
 - xiii. delay in, or denial of, the refund of fees due to a student who withdraws admission within the time mentioned in the prospectus, or as may be notified by the Commission;
 - xiv. complaints of alleged discrimination of students from the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Women, Minority or persons with disabilities categories;
 - xv. denial of quality education as promised at the time of admission or required to be provided; and
 - xvi. harassment or victimization of a student, other than cases of harassment which are to be proceeded against under the penal provisions of any law for the time being in force.
- (i) "Institution" means, as the context may be, a University or a college, or an institution deemed to be a University under the Act or an institution established within a University, for a particular discipline or activity.
- (j) "Institutional Student Grievance Redressal Committee" (ISGRC) means a committee constituted under these regulations at the level of the University, for dealing with grievances which may belong to a department of the University e.g. hostels and common facilities.
- (k) "Ombudsperson" means the Ombudsperson appointed under these regulations.
- (l) "Prospectus" means and includes any publication, whether in print or otherwise, issued for providing fair and transparent information, relating to an institution, to the general public (including to those seeking admission in such institution) by such institution or any authority or person authorized by such institution to do so.


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(m) "Region" means a geographical territory, comprising of States, so determined, for the purpose of facilitating enforcement of these regulations; namely, South-Eastern Region comprising Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Puducherry, Andaman and Nicobar, and Tamil Nadu; South Western Region comprising Kerala, Karnataka, and Lakshadweep; Western Region comprising Maharashtra, Gujarat, Goa, Dadar and Nagar Haveli, Daman and Diu; Central Region comprising Chhattisgarh, Madhya Pradesh and Rajasthan; Northern Region comprising Jammu and Kashmir, Delhi, Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Haryana, Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand and Chandigarh; North-Eastern Region comprising Assam, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Manipur, Tripura, Arunachal Pradesh, Sikkim and Nagaland; and Eastern Region comprising West Bengal, Bihar, Jharkhand and Odisha.

(n) "State" means a State specified in the First Schedule to the Constitution and includes a Union territory;

(o) "Student" means a person enrolled, or seeking admission to be enrolled, in any institution to which these regulations apply;


(p) "University" means a University so defined in clause (f) of section 2 of the Act or, where the context may be, an institution deemed to be University declared as such under Section 3 thereof.

(q) "University Student Grievance Redressal Committee" (USGRC) means a committee constituted under these regulations, at the level of the university, for dealing with grievances arising out of decisions of the DSGRC, ISGRC or CSGRC.

4. MANDATORY PUBLICATION OF PROSPECTUS, ITS CONTENTS AND PRICING:

(1) Every institution, shall publish and/or upload on its website, before expiry of at least sixty days prior to the date of the commencement of the admission to any of its courses or programs of study, a prospectus containing the following for the information of persons intending to seek admission to such institution and the general public, namely:

- the list of programs of study and courses offered along with the broad outlines of the syllabus specified by the appropriate statutory authority or by the institution, as the case may be, for every course or program of study, including teaching hours, practical sessions and other assignments;
- the number of seats approved by the appropriate statutory authority in respect of each course or program of study for the academic year for which admission is proposed to be made;
- the conditions of educational qualifications and eligibility including the minimum and maximum age limit of persons for admission as a student in a particular course or program of study, specified by the institution;
- the process of selection of eligible candidates applying for such admission, including all relevant information in regard to the details of test or examination for selecting such candidates for admission to each course or program of study and the amount of fee prescribed for the admission test;
- each component of the fee, deposits and other charges payable by the students admitted to such institution for pursuing a course or program of study and the other terms and conditions of such payment;
- rules/regulations for imposition and collection of any fines in specified heads or categories, minimum and maximum fine may be imposed.
- the percentage of tuition fee and other charges refundable to a student admitted in such institution in case such student withdraws from such institution before or after completion of course or program of study and the time within and the manner in which such refund shall be made to that student;
- details of the teaching faculty, including their educational qualifications, along with their type of appointment (Regular/visiting/guest) and teaching experience of every member thereof;
- information with regard to physical and academic infrastructure and other facilities including hostel accommodation and its fee, library, hospital or industry wherein the practical training is



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to be imparted to the students and in particular the amenities accessible by students on being admitted to the institution;

- (j) all relevant instructions in regard to maintaining the discipline by students within or outside the campus of the institution, and, in particular such discipline relating to the prohibition of ragging of any student or students and the consequences thereof and for violating the provisions of any regulation in this behalf made by the relevant statutory regulatory authority and

(k) Any other information as may be specified by the Commission:

Provided that an institution shall publish/upload information referred to in clauses (a) to (k) of this regulation, on its website, and the attention of prospective students and the general public shall be drawn to such publication being on the website through advertisements displayed in different newspapers and through other media.

- (2) Every institution shall fix the price of each printed copy of the prospectus, being not more than the reasonable cost of its publication and distribution and no profit be made out of the publication or distribution or sale of prospectus


STUDENT GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL COMMITTEES (SGRC)

A. Collegiate Student Grievance Redressal Committee (CSGRC)

- (i) A complaint from an aggrieved student relating to a college shall be addressed to the Collegiate Student Grievance Redressal Committee (CSGRC), with the following composition, namely:
- Principal of the college - Chairperson,
 - Three senior members of the teaching faculty to be nominated by the Principal - Members:
 - A representative from among students of the college to be nominated by the Principal based on academic merit/excellence in sports/performance in co-curricular activities - Special Invitee.
- (ii) The term of the members and the special invitee shall be two years.
- (iii) The quorum for the meeting including the Chairperson, but excluding the special invitee, shall be three.
- (iv) In considering the grievances before it, the CSGRC shall follow principles of natural justice.
- (v) The CSGRC shall send its report with recommendations, if any, to the Vice-Chancellor of the affiliating University and a copy thereof to the aggrieved student within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of the complaint.

B. Departmental Student Grievance Redressal Committee (DSGRC)

- (i) A complaint by an aggrieved student relating to a Department or School or Centre of a University shall be addressed to the Departmental Student Grievance Redressal Committee (DSGRC) to be constituted at the level of the Department, School or Centre, as the case may be, and with the following composition, namely:
- Head of the Department, School, or the Centre, by whatever designation known - Chairperson;
 - Two Professors, from outside the Department/School/Centre to be nominated by the Vice-Chancellor - Members;
 - A member of the faculty, well-versed with the mechanism of grievance redressal to be nominated by the Chairperson - Member;
 - A representative from among students of the college to be nominated by the Vice-Chancellor based on academic merit/excellence in sports/performance in co-curricular activities - Special Invitee.



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
- (ii) The term of the Chairperson, members of the Committee, and the special invitee shall be of two years.
- (iii) The quorum for the meeting of DSGRC, including the Chairperson, but excluding the special invitee, shall be three.
- (iv) In considering the grievances before it, the DSGRC shall follow principles of natural justice.
- (v) The DSGRC shall submit its report with recommendations, if any, to the Head of the Institution/ Vice Chancellor, with a copy thereof to the aggrieved student, within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of the complaint.

C. Institutional Student Grievance Redressal Committee (ISGRC)

- (i) Where a complaint does not relate to any academic Department, School or Centre of a University, as the case may be, the matter shall be referred to the Institutional Student Grievance Redressal Committee (ISGRC) to be constituted by the Vice Chancellor, with the following composition, namely:
 - (a) Pro-Vice Chancellor/Dean/Senior Professor of Institution - Chairperson.
 - (b) Dean of students/Dean, Students Welfare - Member.
 - (c) One senior academic, other than the Chairperson - Member.
 - (d) Proctor/Senior academic - Member.
 - (e) A representative from among students of the college to be nominated by the Vice Chancellor based on academic merit/excellence in sports/performance in co-curricular activities - Special Invitee.
- (ii) The term of the members of the committee shall be of two years.
- (iii) The quorum for the meetings of the ISGRC, including the Chairperson, but excluding the special invitee, shall be three.
- (iv) In considering the grievances before it, the ISGRC shall follow principles of natural justice.
- (v) The ISGRC shall send its report with recommendations, if any, to the Vice Chancellor, along with a copy thereof to the aggrieved student, within a period of 15 working days from the date of receipt of the grievance.

D. University Student Grievance Redressal Committee (USGRC)

- (i) The Vice Chancellor of an affiliating University shall constitute such number of University Student Grievance Redressal Committees (USGRC), as may be required to consider grievances unresolved by one or more CSGRC or DSGRC or ISGRC and each USGRC may take up grievances arising from colleges/departments/institutions, on the basis of the jurisdiction assigned to it by the Vice Chancellor.
 - a) A senior Professor of the University - Chairperson.
 - b) Dean, Student Welfare or equivalent - Member.
 - c) Two Principals drawn from the affiliating colleges, other than those connected with reports of CSGRC under review, to be nominated by the Vice Chancellor - Members.
 - d) One Professor of the University - Member.
 - e) A representative from among students of the college to be nominated by the Vice Chancellor based on academic merit/excellence in sports/performance in co-curricular activities - Special Invitee.
- (ii) The Chairperson, members and the special invitee shall have a term of two years.
- (iii) The quorum for the meeting, including the Chairperson, but excluding the special invitee, shall be three.


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
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- (iv) In considering the grievances before it, the USGRC shall follow principles of natural justice
- (v) The USGRC shall send its report and recommendations, if any, to the Principal of the College relating to the grievance/Head of the department/School/Institution with a copy thereof to the aggrieved student, within 15 days of the receipt of the grievance.
- (vi) Any student aggrieved by the decision of the University Student Grievance Redressal Committee may prefer an appeal to the Ombudsperson, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of such decision.


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APPOINTMENT, TENURE, REMOVAL AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICES OF OMBUDSPERSON:

- (i) There shall be one or more part-time functionaries designated as Ombudspersons to hear and decide on, appeals preferred against the decisions of the USGRCs.
 Provided that, there shall not be more than one ombudsperson for a State, in respect of all its State universities (Public as well as Private) in that State, who shall be appointed by the State Government.
 Provided further that, there shall not be more than one Ombudsperson for a region in respect of the Central universities and institutions deemed to be universities in that region, who shall be appointed by the Central Government.
- (ii) The Ombudsperson shall be a person of eminence in academics or research, who had been Vice Chancellor of a University.
- (iii) The Ombudsperson for the State universities in a State, shall not be in any conflict of interest with any University in that State; and the Ombudsperson for the Central universities and institutions deemed to be universities in a region, shall not be in any conflict of interest with any University or institution deemed to be University in that region, either before or after such appointment.
- (iv) A State Government shall appoint the Ombudsperson from a panel of three names recommended by a search committee constituted for that purpose and consisting of the following, namely:
 - (a) A nominee of the Governor or Lt. Governor, as the case may be, who is a person of eminence in the field of higher education- Chairperson;
 - (b) A Vice Chancellor from a State Public University to be nominated by the Governor/G of the State/UT - Member;
 - (c) A Vice Chancellor from a State Private University to be nominated by the State Government - Member;
 - (d) Chairperson of the State Council of Higher Education or his/her nominee from among the academic members of the Council- Member;
 - (e) Principal Secretary/Secretary to the State Government responsible for Higher Education - Member Secretary.
- (v) The Central Government shall appoint the Ombudsperson for a region from a panel of three names recommended by a search committee to be constituted for that purpose, and consisting of the following, namely:
 - (a) Chairperson, University Grants Commission or his/her nominee - Chairperson
 - (b) A Vice Chancellor of a Central University to be nominated by the Central Government - Member
 - (c) A Vice Chancellor of an institution deemed to be University to be nominated by the Central Government - Member
 - (d) A nominee of the Central Government, not below the rank of the Joint Secretary - Member
 - (e) Secretary, University Grants Commission - Member Secretary



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
- (vi) The Ombudsperson shall be appointed for a period of three years or until he attains the age of 70 years, whichever is earlier, from the date of assuming office, and shall be eligible for reappointment for another one term for the same State or region, as the case may be.
- (vii) For conducting the hearings, the Ombudsperson shall be paid a sitting fee, per diem, in accordance with the norms fixed by the University Grants Commission, and shall, in addition, be eligible for reimbursement of the expenditure incurred on conveyance.
- (viii) The State Government, in the case of an Ombudsperson of a State, and the Central Government, in the case of an Ombudsperson of a region, may remove the Ombudsperson from office, on charges of proven misconduct or misbehavior as defined under these regulations.
- (ix) No order of removal of Ombudsperson shall be made except after an inquiry made in this regard by a person not below the rank of judge of the High Court in which a reasonable opportunity of being heard is given to the Ombudsperson.

7. FUNCTIONS OF OMBUDSPERSON:

- (i) The Ombudsperson shall hear appeals from an aggrieved student, only after the student has availed all other remedies provided under these regulations.
- (ii) While issues of malpractices in the conduct of examination or in the process of evaluation may be referred to the Ombudsperson, no appeal or application for revaluation or re-totalling of answer sheets from an examination, shall be entertained by the Ombudsperson unless specific irregularity materially affecting the outcome of specific instance of discrimination is indicated.
- (iii) The Ombudsperson may avail assistance of any person, as amicus curiae, for hearing complaints of alleged discrimination.
- (iv) The Ombudsperson shall make all efforts to resolve the grievances within a period of 30 days of receiving the appeal from the aggrieved student(s).

8. PROCEDURE FOR REDRESSAL OF GRIEVANCES BY OMBUDSPERSONS AND STUDENT GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL COMMITTEES:

- (i) Each institution shall, within a period of three months from the date of issue of this notification, have an online portal where any aggrieved student may submit an application seeking redressal of grievance.
- (ii) On receipt of an online complaint, the institution shall refer the complaint to the appropriate Student Grievance Redressal Committee, along with its comments within 15 days of receipt of complaint on the online portal.
- (iii) The Student Grievance Redressal Committee, as the case may be, shall fix a date for hearing the complaint which shall be communicated to the institution and the aggrieved student.
- (iv) An aggrieved student may appear either in person or authorize a representative to present the case.
- (v) Grievances not resolved by the University Student Grievance Redressal Committee shall be referred to the Ombudsperson, within the time period provided in these regulations.
- (vi) Institutions shall extend co-operation to the Ombudsperson or the Student Grievance Redressal Committee(s), as the case may be, in early redressal of grievances; and failure to do so may be reported by the Ombudsperson to the Commission, which shall take action in accordance with the provisions of these regulations.
- (vii) The Ombudsperson shall, after giving reasonable opportunities of being heard to both parties, on the conclusion of proceedings, pass such order, with reasons there for, as may be deemed fit to redress the grievance and provide such relief as may be appropriate to the aggrieved student.
- (viii) The institution, as well as the aggrieved student, shall be provided with, copies of the order, under the signature of the Ombudsperson, and the institution shall place it for general information on its website.



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- (ix) The institution shall comply with the recommendations of the Ombudsperson, and the Ombudsperson shall report to the Commission any failure on the part of the institution to comply with the recommendations.
- (x) The Ombudsperson may recommend appropriate action against the complainant, where a complaint is found to be false or frivolous.

9. INFORMATION REGARDING OMBUDSPERSONS AND STUDENT GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL COMMITTEES:

An institution shall furnish, prominently, on its website, and in its prospectus, all relevant information in respect of the Student Grievance Redressal Committees, coming in its purview, and the Ombudsperson, for the purpose of appeals.

10. CONSEQUENCES OF NON-COMPLIANCE:

The Commission shall in respect of any institution, which willfully contravenes the requirements of, or repeatedly fails to comply with the recommendation of the Ombudsperson or the Grievance Redressal Committees, as the case may be, proceed to take one or more of the following actions: (PART 2)

- withdrawal of declaration of fitness to receive grants under section 12B of the Act;
- withholding any grant allocated to the Institution;
- declaring the institution ineligible for consideration for any assistance under any of the general or special assistance programs of the Commission;
- informing the general public, including potential candidates for admission, through a notice displayed prominently in suitable media and posted on the website of the Commission, declaring that the institution does not possess the minimum standards for redressal of grievances;
- recommend to the affiliating University, for withdrawal of affiliation, in case of a college;
- take such action as it may deem necessary, appropriate, and appropriate in the interest of the institution, in case of a University;
- recommend to the Central Government, if required, for withdrawal of declaration of institution deemed to be a University, in case of an institution deemed to be a University;
- recommend to the State Government to take necessary and appropriate action, in case of a University established or incorporated under a State Act;
- such other action as may be deemed necessary and appropriate against an institution for non-compliance.

Provided that no action shall be taken by the Commission under this regulation, unless the institution has been given an opportunity to explain its position and an opportunity of being heard has been provided to it.

11. Nothing mentioned hereinabove in these regulations shall affect the continuance in office, during the currency of the term, of an incumbent Ombudsperson appointed under the provisions of the UGC (Grievance Redressal) Regulations, 2012; where after, the appointment of Ombudsperson shall be made as per University Grants Commission (Redress of Grievances of Students) Regulations, 2019.

Prof. RAJESH KUMAR

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Ambulance to carry the sick students to general hospitals. The Health Centre provides its services during games, physical sports and functions organized by university. The students, the employees & their dependents of the university are availing the medical facilities being provided by the University Health Centre.

13. YOUTH RED CROSS

Youth are the pillars and future leaders of the country. Today's youth is tomorrow's India. The Youth Red Cross, the youngest wing of India Red Cross Society, Haryana State Branch is active at the University Level. A Youth Red Cross Unit is working in the University Campus for this purpose. A fifteen member YRC Committee of CDLU, Sirsa has been constituted under the chairmanship of the Vice-Chancellor to promote the YRC activities in all the colleges/institutions within the jurisdiction of the university. Meeting of Executive Committee at University Level and of students volunteers are called from time to time to decide about the YRC future plans.

14. NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME

National Service Scheme (NSS) is a noble experiment in academic expansion. It inculcates the spirit of voluntary work among the students and teachers through sustained community interactions. It brings out academic institutions closer to society. It shows how to combine knowledge and action to achieve results, which are desirable for community development. National Service Scheme at this University has been established with the objective of providing students with an opportunity to develop their overall personality by taking part in various Social Service Schemes.

An NSS Committee at University Level is constituted under the Chairmanship of the Vice-Chancellor. There are 34 units of NSS in the University, two of University Teaching Departments and others in various affiliated colleges of Sirsa and Fatehabad Districts. There are two units of SFS also in affiliating colleges. Participation of the student volunteers of the university in National Republic Parade is a matter of pride for us.

15. DEAN RESEARCH

Dean of Research makes efforts to plan activities and take adequate measures for promotion of research in the University. New ordinances are prepared and the old ones are amended as per requirement and in compliance of the U.G.C. guidelines to achieve qualitative enrichment in research. The office aims to launch schemes for in-house proposal of research projects. Of late it has also started the initiative of stimulating the process of various fellowships in the University for timely dispensation of cases. The cell aims at developing and drafting University Research Policy soon.

16. RTI CELL

The RTI Cell deals with RTI applications and RTI appeals on behalf of the University under the provision of the RTI Act and provides information to the information seekers.

17. ANTI RAGGING COMMITTEE

Anti-Ragging Committee supported by Anti Ragging Squad and a Nodal Officer ensures that

there are no incidences of Ragging, bullying and baiting of new students on the campus. Ragging is a criminal offence and is strictly prohibited in the University. A student, if affected, can approach the Nodal Officer to redress his complaint. The Committee comprises Proctor, Dean Student's Welfare, Chief Wardens, Director Youth Welfare, Assistant Dean Students' Welfare and Hostel Wardens are also members of the Anti Ragging Committee/ Squad/Cell. The Anti Ragging Committee also has some outside members prominent along whom are SDM and DSP head quarter Sirsa besides some other important citizen of Sirsa.

18. ANTI EVE-TEASING COMMITTEE

EVE-teasing is a criminal offence. Making unwanted gestures towards girls or passing offensive comments are not only immoral acts but also subject to penal action under Indian Penal Code. Boys student are advised not to indulge in such acts. University has an Anti-Eve teasing Committee headed by the Vice-Chancellor. The Committee comprises Dean Academic Affairs, Proctor, Chief Warden, Dean Students Welfare, Dean of Colleges, Controller of Examination, Lady Warden, SDM Sirsa, City Magistrate, Sirsa, DSP (HQ), Sirsa, SHO (City), Sirsa besides some student representatives and important citizens are also its members.

19. CONSTRUCTION BRANCH

Construction Branch undertakes construction work of various infrastructural projects and strives to keep a quality and maintenance thereof. Because of their efforts, the university has strong infrastructure, which includes

- Three teaching blocks namely Tagore Bhawan, CV Raman & Ambedkar Bhawan
- Two Boys Hostels, Three Girls Hostels,
- V.C's. residence, Faculty House, university of H, C, D, E, F & E-II categories,
- Water Treatment Plant, Over Head Service Reservoir, Boundary Wall on undisputed land, Water Supply and Sewage Scheme, OHSR, STP.
- Media Centre, Library Building, centralized AC Multipurpose Hall with sports flooring, gym, squash room etc, Block "A" of Administrative Block, Shopping complex, Internal Roads (Phase-II) & Parking
- 11 KV Indoor Electric main Sub Station and Compact Sub Station
- Health Centre.
- The branch of Oriental Bank of Commerce with ATM is being run in the building of Shopping Complex.
- Silent Generator Sets are also made available in the university to meet out the requirement of power during power failure.

The works "Construction of Super H, C, D, E & F type houses, Construction of Construction of Water storage tank and providing sprinkler system in lawns & construction of Day Care Centre" are in progress. The fresh proposals i.e. Teaching Block No.4, Solar Energy Plant, Solar Water Heater Systems, more residential houses, construction of university boundary wall, construction of swimming pool, providing & laying of retractable chair at MP Hall, Construction & establishment of Herbal Parks, Construction of VIP Guest House, Construction of Transit Hostel, Extension of Construction Branch, Extension of Boys Hostel No.1, Construction of Class Rooms & Seminar Hall, Extension of Tagore Bhawan, Construction of Information & Guidance Bureau, renovation of Cafeteria in Shopping

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Complex & MP Hall, renovation of class rooms & laboratories in Teaching Block No. 1 & 2 and providing Gym equipments in four hostels etc. are in pipeline.

20. UNIVERSITY CENTRE FOR DISTANCE LEARNING (UCDL)

The University Centre for Distance Learning has been functioning since 2006 with the objective to take University based education beyond the four walls of the University and providing education at the door step for those who are deprived of privilege of education. The UC DL offers 14 programmes i.e. Master of Computer Applications, Master of Science (Computer Science) Master of Business Administration (General), Master of Arts (Education), Master of Arts (Mass Communication), Master of Arts (English), PG Diploma in Mass Communication (PGDMC), PG Diploma in Computer Applications (PGDCA), PG Diploma in Business Management (PGDBM), Bachelor of Computer Applications (BCA), Diploma in Computer Science & Technology(DCST), Bachelor of Arts (Mass Communication) Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com.) and Bachelor of Arts (General). The Distance Education Bureau (DEB), New Delhi has given provisional recognition to the programmes run by University Centre for Distance Learning vide F.No.UGC/DEB/CDLU/HAR/2016 dated 10.11.2016. UC DL has established a well-equipped Library and a computer equipped information cell for the convenience of the students. For seeking day-to-day information of the University Centre for Distance Learning, University Website www.cdlu.ac.in is updated regularly.

CHAPTER- IX

ORDINANCE: RESIDENCE, HEALTH AND DISCIPLINE.

1.(1) Every student on joining one of the University Departments/Colleges on the campus of the University will as far as possible, be accommodated in one of the University Hostels. Only bonafide students admitted to a programme of studies of the University and admitted to a Hostel will be permitted to reside therein. Unless otherwise exempted on medical or other grounds, every resident student shall be required to join the Hostel Mess.

Residents shall not accommodate any person in their rooms without the written permission of the Warden of the Hostel. Any violation of this rule may result in the expulsion of the concerned resident from the hostel by the Chief Warden as also liable to any other punishment provided for in the Rules of the University and approved by the Vice-Chancellor on the recommendation of the Proctorial Committee.

All the students, especially the Resident Students and Hostel Staff, shall compulsorily have the following vaccination/inoculation :-

- (i) Typhoid/Paratyphoid every year;
- (ii) Small-pox every 3 to 5 years;
- (iii) Cholera during epidemics.

(2).(a) Every student, exempted from residence in the Hostel, shall live either with a parent or some person accepted by the Principal of his College or the Chairperson of the Department concerned, as the case may be, to be his Guardian.

(b) The lodgings of such non-resident students shall be subject to the approval of the Principal of his College or the Chairperson of the Department concerned.

2. (1) Subject to the control of the Academic Council/Executive Council there shall be a Board of Residence, Health and Discipline constituted as follows :

1. Proctor (Chairman and Convener);
2. Dean of Students' Welfare;
3. Chief Warden;
4. Deputy Proctor to be appointed by the Vice-Chancellor from amongst the Teachers of University.
5. Principals of Colleges on the Campus;
6. University Medical Officer.
7. Two persons, including a woman, appointed by the Academic Council not necessarily from among their own members;
8. Two teachers of the University other than the Chairpersons of the Departments to be nominated by the Vice-Chancellor;

Provided that the Chairman of the Board may associate any Chairperson/Chairpersons of the University Teaching Department(s) with the proceedings of the Board.

Provided further that in the absence of the Proctor, the Dean of Students' Welfare, and in his absence, the Chief Warden will act as Chairman and Convener of the Board.

Subject to Clause 4, this Board shall operate so far as Departments and Colleges on the Campus are concerned.

(2) The members of the Board, other than ex-officio members, shall hold office for a period of two years. $2/5^{\text{th}}$ of the members will form the quorum.

(3) The Board shall inspect, once in every Academic year, each College and such buildings as may be occupied or used by students and shall submit a report to the Vice-Chancellor with such recommendations as it may think fit, regarding compliance with conditions of residence as laid down by the Ordinances.

(4) As soon as possible in the first Academic term of each Session, the Chief Warden/Principals of Colleges in-charge of the Halls of Residences shall submit to the Board the following information :-

(a) The number of Halls under their control and the names of Wardens.

(b) The number of resident students in each Hostel.

(c) The number of non-resident students living with their parents.

(d) The number of non-resident students living with their guardians.

(5) (a) The Board shall be an advisory body for making, modifying or suggesting policy matters placed before it by the Vice-Chancellor.

(b) The recommendations of the Board shall be implemented after due examination, modification or amendment, if necessary, and approval of the Vice-Chancellor.

(c) For dealing with day-to-day disciplinary matters concerning students a 'Proctorial Committee' as under shall be formed :

(i) Proctor (Convener)

(ii) Dean, Students' Welfare

(iii) Chief Warden

(iv) Two senior lady teachers as nominated by the Vice-Chancellor (to sit on the Committee only when a girl student is involved in a disciplinary case).

(v) One Reader and one Lecturer as may be nominated by the Vice-Chancellor.

(vi) The Principals of the colleges on the Campus (to sit on the Committee only when the case of a student of his/her college is referred by him/her to the Vice-Chancellor and is placed before the Proctorial Committee of the University Campus).

(d) If the Head of the Institution mentioned in sub-clause 4(a) thinks that the student should be expelled from the University, he will refer the case to the Vice-Chancellor who will have the matter enquired by the Proctorial Committee and pass such orders as he/she deems fit on a report submitted by the said Committee.

(e) The decision of the Proctorial Committee shall be binding on all concerned.

(6) The Colleges shall provide, if necessary, in co-operation with the University, facilities for the physical exercise of their students. The Board shall satisfy itself that suitable facilities in such respect exist and submit a report to the Academic Council/Executive Council, once every year, with such recommendations as it thinks fit. #

6.3 (a) Subject to the general control of the Academic Council/Executive Council, the Vice-Chancellor shall have, vested in him, all powers relating to discipline and disciplinary action. He/she may delegate such of his powers as he/she deems proper to the Proctor, Dean of Students' Welfare, the Chief Warden, the Chairpersons of the University Departments/Principals of the Colleges and to such other persons as he/she may specify in this behalf. The powers shall include expulsion, rustication, ban on entry into the University Campus, ban/cancellation of admission to course of study/University Examinations, imposition of fine up to Rs.500/-, issuance of warnings etc., as deemed proper by the concerned authority.

(b) The Board shall deal with any matter concerning Health or Residence which is referred to it by the Vice-Chancellor.

7.4 (a) Without prejudice to the powers of the Vice-Chancellor, Principals of the colleges affiliated to/maintained by the University shall have authority to exercise all such disciplinary powers over the students in their respective colleges as may be necessary for the maintenance of proper discipline. Besides other penalties indicated in Clause 3(a) above, such a Principal can expel a student from his/her college for any period considered appropriate after observing rules of natural justice. The Principal shall appoint a Proctorial Committee to enquire into cases of

indiscipline, misbehaviour or any other matters committed by students which are prejudicial to the proper management of the College. The College Proctorial Committee shall make suitable recommendations for consideration and decision by the Principal.

(b) The Principals of all colleges mentioned in Clause 4(a) above may make such supplementary rules of discipline and proper conduct, not inconsistent with the rules contained in this Ordinance, as they think necessary.

(a) At the time of admission, every candidate shall be required to give an undertaking of good behaviour and not to indulge in any kind of ragging, duly endorsed by his/her parents/guardian as specified by the University authorities. This will imply his/her conforming to the rules and regulations of the College and of the University (including the Hostel Regulations if he/she is residing in a Hostel), as prevailing/modified from time to time.

'Ragging' shall include any act of omission or commission by any person indulging directly or indirectly in any kind of teasing, indecent behaviour including hooliganism, causing annoyance or inconvenience to the students or the outsiders on the campus and/or to the residents on the campus, as the case may be.

(b) Acts of indiscipline/misbehaviour shall include all such actions on the part of a student or a group of students, which in the opinion of the Vice-Chancellor/other authorities of the College/University are violative of any Statute, Ordinance and Rules and Regulations of the College/University, orders passed by the authorities of the College/University and are unbecoming of a student or may cause or have already resulted in disturbing the academic atmosphere, peace and tranquillity in the College/University Campus as well as outside.

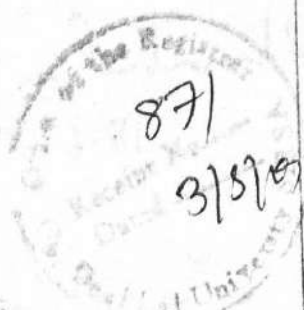



Ram Kumar student of M.P.Ed. 4th Sem and Mr. Yashveer Gujjar student of B.P.Ed along with two outsiders consumed alcohol in the hostel and then switched-off the main electric connection of the hostel. when attendant asked them to maintain the discipline in the hostel, then they abused and slapped the attendant and break away the CCTV camera (of main gate of the hostel), notice board and 3-seater chairs of the common room of the hostel. When I visited the hostel and found that Mr. Suresh Kumar and Mr. Yashveer Gujjar had consumed excess quantity of alcohol and were out of sense. They were creating indiscipline in the hostel premises and abusing in a very loud voice and threatening the attendant to see him and again slapped the attendant and quarreled with the other hostel residents also. When I asked them to maintain the discipline then they misbehaved with me also. Since Mr. Suresh Kumar and Mr. Yashveer Gujjar have damaged the hostel property, disturbed the entire hostel and violated the hostel rules and regulations. So, these student are not allowed to enter in the hostel premises. You are also requested to take further necessary action against the above said students in this regard.

The Committee decided to intimate the COE as well as Chairperson Department of Physical Education for withholding of their result in case, they failed to deposit the fine for the damages done by them.



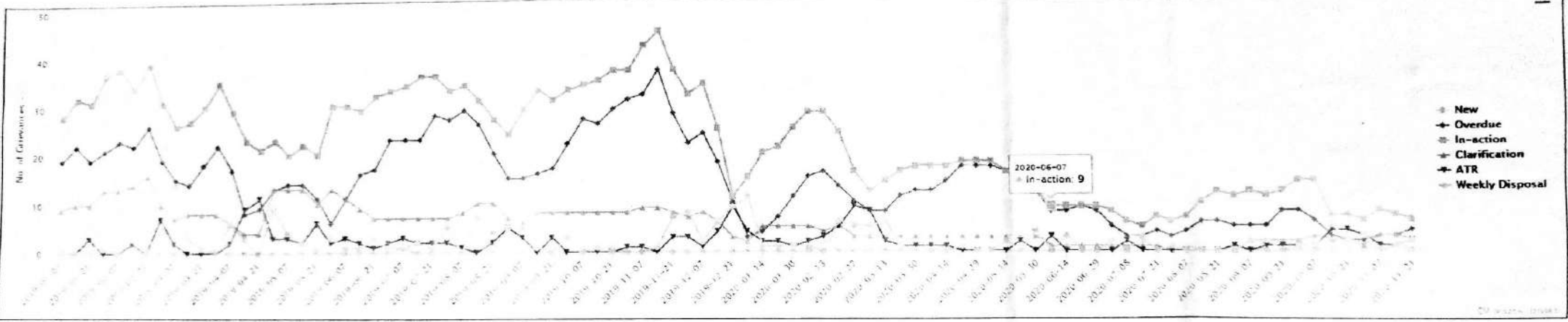
