URS shall be tenable for two years in the first instance which shall be extendable on yearly extension basis ordinarily for a period of one year, but in no case beyond a period of two years by the Vice-Chancellor subject to explicit certification in support of satisfactory work progress on the recommendations of the Supervisor(s) and the Chairperson of the Department.
3. In addition, an annual contingency grant of `5000/- shall be admissible to the scholar for the purpose of stationery, TA/DA and miscellaneous expenses.
